

Home Maintenance Program

This program covers wide range of small repair and maintenance tasks in the home including things such as repair and replacement of taps and tap washers, repair and replacement of door and window locks, minor repair of doors, furniture and walls, installation of smoke alarms and installation of key safes.

Location

Tasmania (coordinated from 24 Sunderland Street, Moonah).

Who can access this service

Frail aged people, people with a mental illness, younger people with a disability and their carers.

Purpose

The Home Maintenance program focuses on the person's most immediate needs as they relate to improving safety and accessibility in their home.

Referral

To request this service, all clients must first register with either My Aged Care or TasCarepoint.

- I am 65 or over - I should first register with My Aged Care on 1800 200 422
- I am under 65 - I should first register with TasCarepoint on 1300 769 699
- I am a carer - I should call CBS on 1300 227 827

Alternatively, you may contact CBS directly for assistance and/or further information.

Program Details

A wide range of small repair and maintenance tasks are covered including:

- repair and replacement of taps and tap washers
- repair and replacement of door and window locks
- minor repair of doors, furniture and walls
- repair of cupboards and drawers
- installation of shelves
- replacement of toilet seats
- installation of battery operated smoke alarms
- installation of key safes
- other minor household repairs and maintenance.

PLEASE NOTE: Gardening is excluded from this program.

Allocation

Is dependent on overall demand for the service, a client's individual needs and available resources at the time.

*What does the service cost

Basic tasks such as fire alarm battery/light globe replacement incur a \$5 fee and \$5 materials charge (ie \$10). For other than the most basic tasks, a quote will be provided for consideration and approval prior to work commencing. Consumers contribute the cost of materials and the program covers labour costs.

The Home Maintenance Program is funded by the Commonwealth Home Support Program and Home and Community Care Program.
