Program details

The weekday program is negotiated with participants based on supporting the retention of interests and introducing new skills. Fun, companionship and entertainment enhance a person's quality of life by stimulating participants emotionally, mentally and physically. Program activities to achieve this outcome include art and craft, cooking, nature appreciation, gardening, problem-solving, education and day trips. Social groups run on varying days, between 10am

and 3pm Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays). CBS provides a midday meal with drinks and snacks as required. Transport may be available to clients to and from the centres. The Sunday group primarily meets for lunch at the CBS premises. Transport is not available on Sundays.

Clients are encouraged to participate in the planning, delivery and evaluation of all programs.

Allocation

Is dependent on the overall demand for the service, a client's individual needs and available resources at the time.

Funded by the Commonwealth Home Support Program and the Home and Community Care Centre Based Care Program.
